<u>Classes at Sheridan start on Tuesday, September 5th 2017</u>. Wednesday is the day that our program reserves for window display installation and window workshops. VDES18448 has another 3-hour time slot, which is for **class instruction**. On September 6th you can pick up your Drawing and Visual Merchandising Kits, in room B340. You will participate in a window workshop that day. This will be the first of four, three-hour window workshops to introduce you to visual merchandising tools and techniques.

- Section 2 or P02 will take place from 1:00 p.m. 4:00 p.m.

To determine which class section, you are enrolled in please refer to the section number listed after the **majority** of your course codes on your schedule, the section number is represented as P01 or P02, with the exception of the Communications course. Costs of both kits are included in your tuition. The program Technologist, Louise Campbell, will be conducting the workshops and distributing the kits in room E111B.
